The Murder of Joshua John Hunt
Oct 14, 2006 age 16 in Edmonton

10 inch Knife through the heart

Hello everyone, I am the proud father of Josh "Treasure". Josh was my best bud, we were very close and now he is gone. When someone is murdered it feels like someone has robbed you and there is a large void in your life. The emotions that you go through race from one to another and back again. We all miss Josh soooooooooo much.

We have visited his grave many times and I stand there looking at it speaking with him. No one deserves to die this way especially Josh and at such a young age 16. Josh had many friends, and I mean many friends. Can you imagine if he lived to become an adult, how many lives's he would of touched? He was truly an amazing kid. He was a loving heart felt guy that touched everyone including me in a very special way. He taught us so much. He never judged anyone, he liked you and loved you for who you were even when you made a mistake. There will never be another Josh like him in this world.

On October 14, 2006 at approx 2:45 am, Josh was stabbed by Alex Jens with a 10 inch knife through his heart and lung and died. On October 14, 2006 at approx 3 am my wife and I heard a terrible knock on our front door. My wife went to the door and I could hear from our bedroom Shawn, Josh's friend with his mother, say Josh was stabbed by Nick's brother and I was trying to tell him to breath. When I heard this I knew this was not going to be good. My wife and I quickly got dressed and drove to the U of A Hospital. During our drive I phoned the emergency department to see how he was. The head doctor came to the phone and told me that he needed to see us right away. I then replied to him is Josh okay and he replied just come in and see us I have to talk to you. I then looked at my wife and told her that I fill sick to my stomach and I feel that this is not going to be good news.

When we arrived at the hospital they put us in a conference room, which seemed like a very cold room and it felt like we were waiting for the doctor for hours, which was only minutes. I looked at my wife across the table and said honey I want you to get prepared for the worst news of our lives. My wife is a very special lady that always tries to be positive, and she replied to me Gary you don't know! he might be in intensive care. (I wish she was right) just then my sister Debbie and brother in law Calvin came in the room and then the doctor, one nurse and the Edmonton City Police started talking to us.

My wife stood up and said I just want to know if our son is alive. That's when we heard the worst news of our lives. Josh had passed away from a stab wound to his heart and lung and they could not save him. My wife and I collapsed with disbelief and it felt like we were in the worst dream of our lives. We have a lot of family and friends that really care and are trying to help us through this huge loss but it hurts more than anything in life.

Josh was buried in a metal sealed casket with his favorite color Blue on Friday October 20 (My sister's birthday) at the West Haven Cemetery located on White mud Freeway and Hwy 21 Edmonton. We were lucky enough to be able to give him a good funeral. There were over 700 people that attended. Josh will always be in our hearts and I know one day we will see him again in heaven.

4 days prior to Josh being murdered (Oct 10, 2006) I had written a letter to The Edmonton Chief of Police Mike Boyd and c/c it to Mayor Steve Mandel, Ralph Klein and Internal Affairs about Josh being jumped by 4 guys in a parking lot on Mothers day May 14, 2006, and other on going harassments by the same guys. After the incident on May 14, 2006 The Police brought him home beaten up and they told my wife and I as well as, my father in law, that they knew who did it (but they didn't lay any charges). So I sent a letter of complaint (because Josh was still being threatened) hoping that someone would care about the safety of Josh.

On October 14, 2006 4 days later Josh was murdered by a guy that was friends of one of the boys that had previously jumped him on May 14, 2006. To this date I have not heard from Mayor Steven Mandel or Ralph Klein, or Internal Affairs or the Chief of Police Mike Boyd and our son is dead.

I want to thank everyone for their continuing cares and help in this very difficult time in our lives. I want to do some public speaking for the young and old in hopes to provide education and programs that can help our teens as well as parents. I don't know where to start so if anyone has any suggestions please e-mail me and let me know.

In regards to our very poor justice system I want to start a petition to get rid of the Young Offenders Act all together and put it back the way they use to do things when we were teens "you did the crime you did the time" no matter if you were an adult or a teen. After all it doesn't make any sense that as parents outside of our homes we have no legal say over our children from 16 years of age and older but you're not an adult in the justice system until you're 18 (it doesn't surprise me with our poor government we have today).

In all honesty the Government should be working for the people of Canada not the other way around like it is now. Being in government is just a big money business with a bunch of people that don't even care. I was speaking with a close friend today and we sat down to try and figure out how we can change the government and the way they think and do things. He suggests that if everyone

in Canada petitioned for changes to get rid of the Young Offenders Act and then if our government doesn't change it quick so there are no other victims then maybe we should all hold back on our income tax as a group coast to coast then the government would be forced to listen and do what the Canadian people want. In Canada we deserve to have safety and have our country run in a way that is for the good of all.

We are asking for the support of everyone

1. To change the Young Offenders Act by removing it all together just like it was before "you do the crime you do the time" lets clean up our streets so we can all be safe.

2. Alex Jens is trying to post bail this November in courtroom 444 at the Edmonton Law Courts. We have been told that he will post bail just like all the other violent offenders recently. If you are opposed to this please fill in the for mentioned petition form and either fax it to (780) 440-3148 or email it to gary.global@shaw.ca and we will collect them and turn them in right away as time is of the essence. Attached please see the three petition forms, one to remove the Young Offenders Act, two to not to have this violent offender released on bail and three that Alex Jens gets tried and sentenced as an adult. You can petition all three or just one or two.

If after we petition the government doesn't listen to us and do the changes we the people of Canada want then maybe my friends suggestion of holding back all income taxes is the only way. After all as he suggests they work for us and they shouldn't get paid until things are fixed. For example: if a carpenter doesn't do the right job then you hold back money until he or she fixes the problem why should it be any different for the government who claims they are working for us.

He knows you are most likely scared of doing this because of the negative power the government has but he said please remember if we all stick together there is more of us than them and they will have very limited power until they start doing the right things. He also suggests in regards to holding back your income tax (if it comes to this which we hope it doesn't) that we don't spend it just hold it back until they do the changes and then we will all pay them gladly. He doesn't think it will come to this and hopes it doesn't because he truly thinks if we stick together they will have no choice but to change things quickly and we need it done quickly for the safety of our youth and all Canadians.

We are willing to lead this with your support and have all of you stand with us through your petition support. We will be honored to help make things right for all of us. If you are serious about change then we are asking for you support for this good cause by sending us a fax or an e-mail petitioning change. Let's see how our government likes freedom of speech. Is Canada really a free democracy? Does our government really care?

Dad misses you very much Josh, it's not the same anymore without you I promise you that I will help make changes so your country is a better place to live. This is my promise to you my son. Good night, dad loves you!
